The Coppell Middle School North Band, the current Texas State CC Honor Band, is scheduled to perform for the Texas Music Educators Convention in San Antonio. The Concert is slated for Friday, February 16, 2:00 pm in the main theatre of the Lila Cockrell performing Arts Center in the San Antonio Convention Center.
